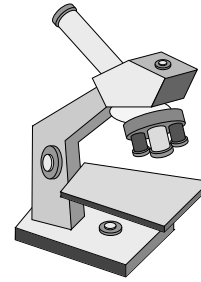
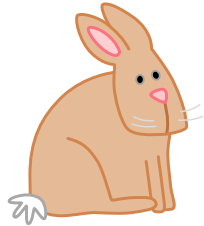
# The Five Senses

I touch with my skin.

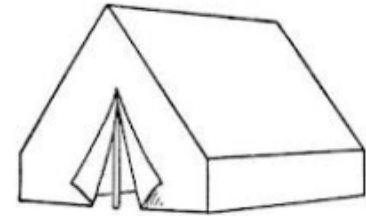
