Remembrance Day

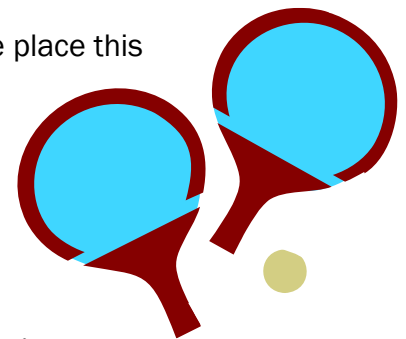
