Are there twelve students in FH Collins interested in a cultural/historical tour of London, Stratford on Avon and a few other notable places?

If so, FH Collins English Department would like to offer students the opportunity to see parts of England during Spring Break, 2010.

Once we have a commitment (that means money and passport and forms filled in), then we can decide on the plays we want to see: *Romeo and Juliet* is on in Stratford, March 11 and 12. From Stratford on Avon, we can visit a medieval castle, Stonehenge, Oxford and then see London.

During the March break, plays such as *Oliver*, *We Will Rock You*, *Grease* and *Billy Elliott* are on in major London theatres. The theatres in London are for the most part, interesting as venues for theatre- Theatre Drury Lane- is the oldest running private theatre and this March, *Oliver* is playing there.

As well, we will visit museums like the British Museum and at least one art gallery like the Tate British or Modern. St. Paul's Cathedral and Westminster Abbey are definitely on the tour. There will be some shopping time and time to check out places like Covent Gardens as well as the London Eye and the Tower Bridge.

The cost of this trip will be somewhere around 4000 dollars if we want to get good tickets to well known plays.
