Zhou Enlai

- Born in 1898
- Participant in student protests in Japanese territory he was briefly imprisoned for his actions
- Largely responsible for China's reestablishing contracts with the west in the early 1970s
- Premier Zhou Enlai died 1976



Cultural Revolution

- April 1966 Mao Zedong started the Cultural Revolution. Started with red guards and closing of public schools.
- Mao Zedong's goals for the Cultural Revolution was to replace his designated successors with people who agree more with his ideas, to repair the communist party, to provide the younger generation in China the experience of



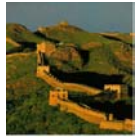
Student Demonstrations

- Students where fighting against democracy.
- Chairman Mao sent in troops with AK47s to silence the students. Estimated 1,200 people where killed.
- The military crackdown ended the protest movement in 1989.



Establishment of the People's Republic in China.

- The October 1 parade in Beijing marked the 50 years since the establishment of the People's Republic.
- The CPP drew up a government council with Mao Zedong as Chairman and Zhou Enlai Premier of the government administration council to establish the People's Republic.



The Great Wall

- The Great Wall is 4,500 miles long and was made during the Ming Dynasty.
